



How a Little Change Can Change the World!

How can a little change brought in by some children in a church in Yuba City, California affect the lives of children at an orphanage half-way around the world in Arusha, Africa? The answer...a lot! Pastors Jim and Kristine Carpenter of The Bridge Church in Marysville, CA decided to take seriously Jesus' words about doing something for the least of these. They had one of our representatives share about Samaritan Village on a Sunday morning this



past March. Their goal was to sponsor a child for \$60 a month. Three classes in the kids' ministry would each

collect a total of \$20 in *change* from the children which would be donated to *change* the world of the children in Africa. They brought all the money they'd collected forward on Easter Sunday. And, let's just say they did a little better than \$60. In fact, they had raised a total of \$1,183.46! Then, in April they raised over \$900! Our God is a multiplying God! Other Ministries That Sponsor a Child



Fifty rambunctious children can be hard on playground equipment, especially trampolines. So, now and then we need to replace some items. We just purchased new slides and


added two new trampolines. The children were thrilled! Just thought our supporters would like to know where some of their donations go!

James 1:27 Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world.

Johnson

Two children were admitted to Samaritan Village on January 27, 2017. They were brought to the orphanage by police and social welfare officers under police Reg.# AR/ RB/1272/2017. The babies had previously been cared for at Esso Village. Esso Village was an unregistered orphanage operating in Arusha. A decision was made by government officials to close all unregistered centers. As a result, all the children from this center had to be distributed to other centers in the area. Samaritan Village was asked to take in these two children. The children's names are Johnson and Pulkeria. Pulkeria has had a sponsor for quite some time, but no one has sponsored Johnson so far. Johnson is eleven years old.

A baby boy was found at night on April 21, 2016. He had been abandoned 12 miles from the town of Arusha. He was crying and naked. Some Samaritans took care of him and reported finding him to the police. These same kind people continued to provide temporary care for the little boy while the police and other security agencies tried to find any relatives. It was especially difficult to find anyone since no one had filed a report about a missing child. Finally, instructions were given by the police and social welfare officers for the baby to be taken to Samaritan Village.
